## Speech@Emerson Financial Aid Checklist

Follow the Steps Below to Apply for Federal Student Aid

Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (<u>FAFSA</u>). Include the Emerson College federal school code: **002146**.

Sign the FAFSA electronically using your Federal Student Aid (FSA) ID. You can create an FSA ID on the Federal Student Aid website, or when logging in to the FAFSA.

If you wish to receive the Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan, complete Entrance Counseling and electronically sign the Loan Agreement Master Promissory Note (MPN) at StudentAid.gov.

- Both the Entrance Counseling and MPN must be completed for funds to be disbursed to your student account at Emerson College.
- If you have previously borrowed federal student loans, be sure to update your lender(s) with contact information and enrollment status (for loan deferment purposes). Log in on the <u>StudentAid.gov</u> homepage to review loan history and loan servicer details.

Evaluate your need for additional funding, such as the Federal Direct Graduate PLUS Loan, through the Department of Education or private education loans through various lenders of your choice.

**Note:** The Direct Graduate PLUS Loan is credit based. Please visit <u>StudentAid.</u> gov for detailed information regarding PLUS loan credit requirements.

Once you have made the decision to apply for the Federal Direct Graduate PLUS Loan, complete the <u>Direct PLUS</u> <u>loan request</u>.

- If approved for the Direct Graduate PLUS Loan, complete a separate Loan Agreement MPN.
- If declined for the Direct Graduate PLUS Loan, you can re-apply with a co-signer (endorser) or appeal the denial through the Department of Education.
